How good could a stage play be with only two actors and one set? The answer: incredible! Last Friday evening, a group from Pantops went together to see one of the Virginia Theater Festival plays at UVA titled, "The Heart Sellers." The play told the story of two immigrant women in 1973 who met at a grocery store while shopping for their family's first 'American Thanksgiving' dinner. They ended up back at one of their apartments trying to cook a thoroughly frozen turkey. Who hasn't been there! As they shared the space of a small apartment, they started to open up about the challenges of leaving home and trying to make a life in a new country. There were awkward silences, outbursts, bold confessions, and many tears. Finding community was hard in 1973 and it is still so difficult today. Watching the play made me proud that Pantops has longstanding partnerships with organizations like the IRC and with families from around the world for whom we have tried to be community over the years.

What also struck me from the play was the importance of empathy. We pass so many people in the grocery stores, the gas stations, and the doctor's office. We don't know their stories or what it is like to walk a day in their shoes. We don't know the struggles that consume them right under the surface of a smile and the usual, 'I'm fine.' Yes, it may be awkward, but what if we took the time to try to learn some of those stories? What if we took the risk to share bits of our story? Would we find the community we long for in the space between two people, us and them, and wouldn't that look like the kingdom of God? In Christ,
